# **OVERVIEW**

Join us at WASCZ for a weekend of culture and celebration. Students will be able to participate in the following competitions: Chamber Music, Solo Piano Category, Solo Music Performances, Composition, Digital Composition, Public Speaking, Acting, Visual Art, Dance, Guitar. These exciting competitions will enable students to showcase their talents during the culture festival.

Each competition follows specific criteria and eligibility, so please check the individualized information bellow for more details.

Students are allowed to enter any competition with the WASCZ Culture Festival 2025. However, they are only allowed to attend each competition once.

At the awards ceremony, all shortlisted finalists will receive a certificate, the winner's school will receive a trophy and the winners a medal.

## **CHAMBER MUSIC**

### **Eligibility**

Entrants must be current students at WAS Changzhou, Hangzhou, Nanjing, or any other invited school. Ensembles must consist of a minimum of 3 players and a maximum of 12 players. Popular music and vocal ensembles are permitted. All ensembles must use their own equipment.

### **Age Categories**

The school grade of the oldest member of the ensemble will be used to determine the age category. Junior: 2-3 minutes Grade 3-6 (recommended minimum ABRSM Grade 3 level)
Intermediate: 3-5 minutes Grade 7-9 (recommended minimum ABRSM Grade 4 level)
Senior: 5-8 minutes Grade 10-12 (recommended minimum ABRSM Grade 5 level)

### **Repertoire and Scores**

Whilst we encourage ensembles to play music in the original scoring, we acknowledge that younger ensembles and wind/brass groups may have to perform arrangements of works. Scores should be provided for the adjudicators at the time of the video submission, with suitable bar numbers/rehearsal figures indicated in the score. Students must perform the same work(s) in both rounds of the competition.

### How to Enter

Each entry should be submitted separately via email. A performance video should be submitted to culturefestival@waiscz.com with a PDF score. The deadline is 28th Feb 2025.

### Round

All video submissions will be reviewed by specialist staff at WASCZ. A maximum of five entries per age category will be invited to perform in the live final at WASCZ.

### Round 2

The final show will be live, onsite at WASCZ, to a panel of specialist adjudicators. The winner will be announced at the award ceremony

### Awards

All shortlisted finalists will receive a certificate, the winners' school will receive a trophy and the winners a medal



# 02-作曲

# **COMPOSITION**

### **Eligibility**

Entrants must be current students at WAS Changzhou, Hangzhou, Nanjing, or any other invited school. The composition may be in any style or genre.

### **Age Categories**

The current school grade will be used to determine the age category.

Junior – Maximum 4 minutes Grade 8 and under

Intermediate – Maximum 6 minutes – Grade 9-10 Senior – Maximum 8 minutes – Grade 11-12

### Adjudication

The specialist adjudicators will review all submissions. All composers will be invited to attend the final round. The top three finalists will be invited to present their full composition, along with a short video presentation of their process at the final round, whilst our specialists in digital composition and songwriting provide feedback on the submissions, before deciding the winners. Finalists will be notified in advance.

### **How to Enter**

Each entry should be submitted separately via email. A performance video should be submitted to culturefestival@waiscz.com with a PDF score. Each entrant must submit one piece only.

Scores can be handwritten or typeset using computer software. Entrants should submit audio alongside their score. This could be a recording of live musicians or software audio. The audio should be submitted in MP3 or WAV format. Composers should submit a short description of their work, including their inspiration compositional techniques. The deadline is 28th Feb 2025.

### **Awards**

All shortlisted finalists will receive a certificate, the winners' school will receive a trophy and the winners a medal.

# 03 数字作曲与创作

# DIGITAL COMPOSITION AND SONGWRITING

### Eligibility

Entrants must be current students at WAS Changzhou, Hangzhou, Nanjing, or any other invited school. The composition must be created in a DAW (Digital Audio Workstation). The composition must be entirely new and has not yet been premiered. Your submission can either be an original production or a remix. The composition may be in any style or genre.

### **Age Categories**

The current school grade will be used to determine the age category. Junior – less than 4 minutes – Grade 8 and under Intermediate – less than 6 minutes – Grade 9-10 Senior – less than 8 minutes – Grade 11-12

### **How to Enter**

Each entrant must submit one piece only. Composers should submit a screenshot of the project and the project file alongside an MP3 audio file. Each entry should be submitted separately via email to culturefestival@waiscz.com . The deadline is 28th Feb 2025.

### Adjudication

The specialist adjudicators will review all submissions. All composers will be invited to attend the final round. The top three finalists will be invited to present their full composition, along with a short video presentation of their process at the final round, whilst our specialists in digital composition and songwriting provide feedback on the submissions, before deciding the winners. Finalists will be notified in advance.

### Awards

All shortlisted finalists will receive a certificate, the winner's school will receive a trophy and the winners a medal.



# **DANCE**

### **Age Categories**

Participants will compete in the following age categories

Baby – KG\ G1 and G2 (1-2.5 minutes)

Intermediate – Grade 7-9 (2-3 minutes)

Junior – G3-G6 (2-2.5 minutes)

Senior – Grade 10-12 (2.5-5 minutes)

### Brief

Participants can choose any of the following four dance styles:

A: Classical: any choreography based on the classical ballet repertoire (i.e., Sleeping Beauty, Swan Lake, Giselle).

B: Neoclassical/ Lyrical Ballet: any choreography based on Classical Ballet technique that is not part of the classical ballet repertoire.

C: Character/ National Dance: all traditional folk dances are allowed. (A Ballet character- dance would NOT apply to this category).

D: Open Category: any dance style is allowed except for Classical/ Neoclassical Ballet, Jazz, Contemporary and Character/ National Dances.

Ensuring the choreography is suited to the contestants' age and capability is imperative. Participants should perform either ONE variation, Duo/Pas de Deux, Group or Ensemble piece but are able to choose any of the above dance styles.

### **Adjudicators**

The judging Criteria for the Dance Competition used by the judges will be: age, level, technique, musicality, choreography, and presentation.

### **How to Enter**

Submit your application and a dance video to culturefestival@waiscz.com. Ensure you provide your music accompaniment in an MP3 format. The deadline is 28th Feb 2025.

**Round 1:** All video submissions will be reviewed by specialist staff at WASCZ. A maximum of five entries will be invited to perform in the final show at WASCZ.

**Round 2:** The final will be live, onsite at WASCZ, to a panel of specialist adjudicators representing each school. The winner will be announced at the award ceremony.

### **Awards**

All shortlisted finalists will receive a certificate, the winner's school will receive a trophy and the winners a medal.



# **Eligibility**

Students of age 9 to 18 years old who study piano as a main instrument. Students may perform music from any musical period or genre and should aim to provide a balanced programme. Popular music properly arranged/transcribed for piano is permitted.

### **Age Categories**

The current school grade of the pianist will be used to determine the age category. Junior: 2-3 minutes Grade 3-6 (recommended minimum ABRSM Grade 3 level) Intermediate: 3-5 minutes Grade 7-9 (recommended minimum ABRSM Grade 4 level) Senior: 5-8 minutes Grade 10-12 (recommended minimum ABRSM Grade 5 level)

Please note, for the Senior category it is a requirement for students to perform their piece from memory on the final round. It is not acceptable for Senior category students to perform with scores.

### **Repertoire and Scores**

While we encourage students to play music in the original scoring, we acknowledge that younger musicians may have to perform arrangements of works. Scores should be provided for the adjudicators at the time of the video submission, with suitable bar numbers/rehearsal figures indicated in the score. Students should not perform the same work in both rounds of the competition.

Each school should provide one music specialist to be part of the panel. One external adjudicator will also be invited to attend (tbc).

### **How to Enter**



## **SOLO MUSIC PERFORMANCE**

### Eligibility

Entrants must be current students at WAS in Changzhou, Hangzhou, Nanjing, or any other invited school. Students may perform alone or with piano accompaniment. Students may perform music from any musical period or genre and should aim to provide a balanced program. Popular music and vocal ensembles are permitted. All performers must source their own equipment. Please note, this competition is NOT for solo piano. Pianists should apply for Solo Piano Performance instead.

### Age Categories

The current school grade of the soloist will be used to determine the age category. Junior: 2-3 minutes Grade 3-6 (recommended minimum ABRSM Grade 3 level) Intermediate: 3-5 minutes Grade 7-9 (recommended minimum ABRSM Grade 4 level) Senior: 5-8 minutes Grade 10-12 (recommended minimum ABRSM Grade 5 level)

### Repertoire and Scores

While we encourage students to play music in the original scoring, we acknowledge that younger musicians and singers may have to perform arrangements of works. Scores should be provided for the adjudicators at the time of the video submission, with suitable bar numbers/rehearsal figures indicated in the score. Students must perform the same work(s) in both rounds of the competition.

Students are strongly encouraged to provide their own accompanist. If you wish to use a WASCZ accompanist, this must be stated in the initial entry submission email. Rehearsal time with the WASCZ accompanist will be limited to 15 minutes on the day of the competition. The use of backing tracks is permitted where appropriate and should be provided in the initial entry submission email using an MP3 file.

### **How to Enter**

Each entry should be submitted separately via email. A performance video should be submitted to culturefestival@waiscz.com with a PDF score. The deadline is 28th Feb 2025...

Round 1: All video submissions will be reviewed by specialist staff at WASCZ. A maximum of five entries per age category will be invited to perform in the live final show at WASCZ.

# 07. 吉他组

## **GUITAR**

### **Eligibility**

Entrants must be current students at WAS Changzhou, Hangzhou, Nanjing, or any other invited school. Students must perform alone, with an acoustic or semi-acoustic instrument; backing tracks are admitted – see specific paragraph below. A microphone and PA system will be provided for amplification.

Students may perform music from any musical period or genre and should aim to provide a balanced programme. All performers must source their own equipment (footstools, ergoplay and similar, tuning devices, other tools).

### **Age Categories**

The current school grade of the soloist will be used to determine the age category. Junior: 2-3 minutes Grade 3-6 (recommended minimum ABRSM/RSL Grade 3 level) Intermediate: 3-5 minutes Grade 7-9 (recommended minimum ABRSM/RSL Grade 4 level) Senior: 5-8 minutes Grade 10-12 (recommended minimum ABRSM/RSL Grade 5 level)

### Repertoire, Music categories and Scores

The competition is addressed to acoustic guitar players of any kind: classical guitar, folk guitar, fingerstyle, plectrum are all welcome. **Pedal boards, loops, effects are not allowed.** Singers/players are also welcome, but the evaluation will be based on the guitar performance only.

There will be a prize for the best guitarist and sub prizes for the best classical performance and the best modern performance.

Whilst we encourage students to play music in the original scoring, we acknowledge that younger musicians have to perform arrangements of works. Scores should be provided for the adjudicators at the time of the video submission, with suitable bar numbers/rehearsal figures indicated in the score.

Students must perform the same work(s) in both rounds of the competition.

### **Accompaniment/Backing tracks**

Students that want to use a backing track must provide their own and should be provided in the initial entry submission email using an MP3 file.

Students in the final round will be given 5 minutes for soundcheck on the day of the competition. We recommend using a semi-acoustic instrument, when performing with a backing track, but acoustic instruments are also accepted.

### **How to Enter**

Each entry should be submitted separately via email. A performance video should be submitted to culturefestival@waiscz.com with a PDF score. The deadline is 28th Feb 2025.

### Round 1


All video submissions will be reviewed by specialist staff at WASCZ. A maximum of five entries per age category will be invited to perform in the live final show at WASCZ.

The final show will be live streaming, onsite at WASCZ, to a panel of specialist adjudicators. The winner will be announced at the award ceremony.

# **ACTING-SOLO**

### **Eligibility**

Entrants must be a current student at WAS Changzhou, Hangzhou, Nanjing, or from any other invited schools.

### **Age Categories**

The current school grade of the soloist will be used to determine the age category.

Junior: Grade 3-6 Intermediate: Grade 7-9 Senior: Grade 10-12

### Script

Students should submit a copy of their selected script(s) along with their video entry. culturefestival@waiscz. com for a list of suggested works per each category.

### **Adjudicators**

Each school should provide one drama specialist to be part of the adjudicating panel.

### How to Enter

Each entry should be made separately via email. A performance video should be submitted to culturefestival@waiscz.com with a PDF script included. The deadline is 28th Feb 2025.

### **Brief**

Junior – Students must perform one scene from a published play from memory. The performance time of the scene must be a minimum of 2 minutes and no longer than 3 minutes.

Intermediate - Students must perform one scene from a published play or feature film from memory. The performance time of the scene must be a minimum of 2 minutes and no longer than 3 minutes.

Senior – Students must perform two scenes, from a published play from memory. The time for each scene should be no longer than 3 minutes.

Students should perform the same work(s) in both rounds of the competition, and it must be by memory.

**Round 1:** All video submissions will be reviewed by specialist staff at WASCZ, with a maximum of 8 entries per age category being invited to perform in the live final at WASCZ.

**Round 2:** The final will be live, onsite at WASCZ, to a panel of specialist adjudicators. The winner will be announced at the award ceremony.

### **Awards**

All shortlisted finalists will receive a certificate, the winner's school will receive a trophy and the winners a medal.

## **PUBLIC SPEAKING**

### Eligibility

Entrants must be a current student at WAS Changzhou, Hangzhou, Nanjing, or from any other invited schools.

### **Age Categories**

The current school grade of the soloist will be used to determine the age category. Junior: Grade 3-6 Intermediate: Grade 7-9 Senior: Grade 10-12

## Script

Students should submit a copy of their speech along with their video entry. Email culturefestival@waiscz. com for a list of suggested works per each category.

### **Adjudicators**

Each school should provide one specialist to be part of the adjudicating panel.

### How to Enter

Each entry should be made separately via email. A performance video should be submitted to culturefestival@waiscz.com with a PDF of their speech included. The deadline is 28th Feb 2025.

### **Brief**

**Junior** – Students must perform a speech about a book of their own choice. The speech must not exceed 2 minutes in length. Note cards, or an electronic device to display notes, may be used.

**Intermediate** – Students must perform a speech about an experience, event or visit of their own choice. The speech must not exceed 3 minutes in length. Note cards, or an electronic device to display notes, may be used. Students can also use a visual aid with the exception of a PowerPoint presentation.

**Senior** – Students must perform a prepared speech about an object of their choice. (For example, a memento, an ornament, a picture that illustrates a happy memory) The speech must not exceed 3 minutes in length. The student must bring in the object and use it as a visual aid, referring to it during the speech. The use of a PowerPoint presentation is not allowed.

Students should perform the same work(s) in both rounds of the competition.

**Round 1:** All video submissions will be reviewed by specialist staff at WASCZ, with a maximum of 8 entries per age category being invited to perform in the live final at WASCZ.

**Round 2:** The final will be live, onsite at WASCZ, to a panel of specialist adjudicators. The winner will be announced at the award ceremony.

**Awards:** All shortlisted finalists will receive a certificate, the winner's school will receive a trophy and the winners a medal.



# 10. 视觉艺术

## **VISUAL ARTS**

### Eligibility

Entrants must be a current student at WAS Changzhou, Hangzhou, Nanjing, or other invited school.

### Age categories

Grade 6-12

### **Brief**

Students may submit work in the following categories: 2D Fine Art (painting, print, drawing), Chinese Painting & Calligraphy, Graphic Design, Illustration & Digital Art, Photography, Film & Animation, 3D (sculpture, models for architecture & interiors, product design, ceramics, etc.)

Any size, Any media

Any subject - although potentially offensive artwork is not eligible for exhibition. Artists should be aware that their work will be visible to young children and seniors, as a guideline artists will be happy to share their artwork with their grandparents.

Artists must submit a label that includes name, grade, school, media, size, and a short description of what inspired them to make the artwork. A guide of 200 words is advised.

### How to enter

Each entry should be made separately via email. Photo(s) of the artwork should be submitted to culturefestival@waiscz.com with a PDF script included. The deadline is 28 Feb 2025.

### **Adjudicators**

Each school should provide one art specialist to be part of the adjudication panel. One external adjudicator will also be invited to attend (tbc).

### **Exhibition and Awards**

All submissions will be reviewed by the specialist adjudicators. All eligible work will be displayed in an exhibition at WASCZ, and all artists will be invited to attend the exhibition. All shortlisted finalists will receive a certificate, the winner's school will receive a trophy and the winners a medal.



## THEATRE LAB

## A Day of Exploration in Performance Arts

### Event Context

Theatre Lab will be a featured event inside the upcoming Cultural Festival, providing a day-long celebration of theatre, performance, and creative exploration. This event will blend live performances with interactive workshops, offering participants and spectators an immersive experience in the world of theatre. The aim is to inspire creativity, foster collaboration, and showcase the talent within our school and community.

**Date:** 20 April 2025 **Duration:** 1 day (Full day event)

### **Objective:**

The goal of Theatre Lab is to engage students, teachers, and community members in hands-on theatrical experiences. By offering both performances and workshops, we aim to:

- · Foster appreciation for the performing arts.
- · Provide a platform for creative expression.
- · Encourage collaboration across age groups and disciplines.
- · Enhance participants' skills in acting and storytelling.

### **Event Structure:**

### 1. Performances

Throughout the day, we will host a variety of performances that showcase the depth of talent of WAS students across all schools. These performances will feature:

- · Short Plays: A series of short dramatic performances or skits, written or directed by students.
- · Monologues: Performances by individual students or teachers, offering a chance to express character and emotion through solo pieces.

### 2. Workshops

In addition to performances, Theatre Lab will offer a variety of workshops designed to engage participants in hands-on learning experiences. Workshops will include:

- · Acting Techniques: A practical workshop on voice, body language, and emotional expression led by experienced teachers or guest performers.
- · Improvisation: An interactive session that teaches the basics of improvisation, helping participants think quickly and creatively on their feet.
- Fundamental Poi Techniques: Learn basic movements such as forward and backward spins, weaves, and butterfly patterns.
- · Clowning Workshop: Participants will explore the principles of physical comedy, improvisation, and exaggerated expression to create unique, memorable characters with a strong emphasis on body language, facial expressions, and comedic timing
- · Showcase Talent: Theatre Lab will provide a stage for those already involved in theatre while also encouraging those new to performance to step into the spotlight.
